CONTEST RULES:

- ❖ Each contestant shall prepare his or her <u>own</u> speech. The contestant may receive advice in the preparation of the speech and may make minor changes or improvements in the speech at any time.
- All the contestants must speak on the theme of the program given to them, "No individual has any right to come into the world without leaving behind a distinct reason for having passed through it."
- ❖ Time allowed for presentation will **NOT** be under *3 minutes* or **OVER** *5 minutes* in length. Contestants will be penalized for each 15 seconds over or under the allotted time.
- ❖ The use of props, special costumes or clothing, or use of prompters will **NOT** be permitted.
- ❖ Contestants will not be permitted to identify his or herself, family, or the geographical or political area from which they originate.
- Contestants will also be penalized for failure to announce the official topic before beginning their speech.
- ❖ Contestants will compete in two divisions. *Division I* accepts contestants grades 6-8 (Middle School) and *Division II* accepts contestants grades 9-12 (High School).
